

CAPTAIN'S SHEET

SYDNEY WESTERN SUBURBS DART LEAGUE INSTRUCTIONS TO TEAM CAPTAINS/CLUB OFFICIALS (UPDATE 2008) SCORESHEET REQUIREMENTS

****IMPORTANT ** KEEP THIS SHEET WITH YOUR SCORE SHEETS ALL TIMES!!!**

FRONT SIDE OF SHEET:

1. Clearly identify team name & number, date, division and venue at top of page.
2. Clearly identify names of players on top of each column. If more than one player with the same Christian name, please identify each individually. E.g. Ron Moore, Ron Murray. Also, please use the same name on both the front and back of the sheet not Tony/Anthony or Bob/Robert.
- 3(a) Score for each walk (three {3} darts) are to be recorded as a total on each line.
- (b) Scores of 180 or 170 peg outs must be recorded in **SPECIAL SCORES** on the back of the sheet and circled.
- (c) Busts and finishes are to be shown as follows: X=1 dart bust, XX=2 darts bust, XXX=3 darts bust. 1F=1 dart finish, 2F=2 darts finish and 3F=3 darts finish.
NOTE!!! If the foregoing is not shown clearly, then it will be assumed that the **MAXIMUM** possible darts were used for the bust or finish.
- 4(a) All columns must be added for number of darts thrown which is circled and total Score placed in bottom of column.
- (b) Ensure in each case that the totals are correct and in accordance with the win or loss totals that would apply to each individual game played.

PENALTY*** One (1) point per match will be deducted for any omissions as detailed.

SHOULD THIS REQUIREMENT BE BLATANTLY AND REPEATEDLY IGNORED, MORE SERIOUS ACTION MAY FOLLOW.

REAR SIDE OF SHEET:

5. Players' names, both Christian and Surname, must be shown on rear of score sheet. E.g. Ron Moore, Ron Murray etc... with Surnames listed alphabetically INCLUDING the Captain. These names must be easily associated with names on the front of the sheet. Captain with a [C] beside them. The same applies on the MIXED sheet whether MALE or FEMALE.

PENALTY*** One (1) point per match will be deducted for each name infringement.

6. **PLAYERS MUST SIGN** in the second column alongside their respective names.

PENALTY*** One (1) point per WINNING GAME the player has played in, in that match.

7. Total scores and total number of darts + averages thrown for the match must be shown for each player in the appropriate column adjacent to their name.

PENALTY*** One (1) point for each infringement, up to total loss of all points scored.

8. Scores of 180 and 170 peg are to be shown in SPECIAL SCORES. **IF NOT shown redress will NOT be allowed later on.**

8. a. High peg of over 95 or higher must be shown in SPECIAL SCORES. **IF NOT SHOWN REDRESS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED LATER ON**

9. Correct details of team names, division number, night of play, date and team numbers of home and away teams with point score results and signatures of the respective captains must be shown in the appropriate spaces provided.

10. NEW REGISTRATIONS (Up to the end of the first round) MUST have the approval of either of the following: RECORDER or PRESIDENT, SECRETARY or TREASURER and MUST be signed by their DARTS CLUB SECRETARY/ORGANISER and by the NEW PLAYER. They must then wait one (1) week after approval before playing. All information must be filled in on REGISTRATION SLIP(S) and no other form(s) will be recognized. Alongside "APPROVED BY" the name of the Office Bearer who authorized it MUST be shown.

PENALTY*** One (1) point will be deducted for each WINNING GAME in which the new player(s) participated, if not approved or registration form(s) not received by Recorder or signed by Club Secretary/Organiser.

11. LATE OR NON-RECEIPT OF SCORE SHEETS Score sheets must be in the hands of the Recorder by MIDNIGHT OF THE FOLLOWING MONDAY after the game was played, whether it was either MONDAY or WEDNESDAY or BOTH.

PENALTY*** WITHOUT ANY EXEMPTION, score sheets received after the Monday specified will incur a fine of \$ 5.00 + a loss of all points for that nights play.

12. PROTESTS or COMPLAINTS, of any nature, MUST BE IN WRITING and addressed to the SECRETARY and must be in his hands within SEVEN (7) DAYS of the date occurred.
13. All entry forms for all League/Special Events Competitions etc., must be read carefully and completed in detail as requested and returned by the closing date Thereon.
14. Captains CANNOT borrow players from another team.
15. Results of last night of play need not be telephoned in they are to be sent in as normal, with late sheet fines still applying ALSO an extra fine of ALL POINTS LOST for the match. This could affect your position in the competition and stop you from playing in the semi's.
16. RESULTS of SEMI-FINALS---FINALS---GRAND FINALS MUST be telephoned to the Recorder AFTER 9:00 a.m. and BEFORE 9:00 p.m. the next day without fail. THEN THE SHEETS ARE POSTED IN AS USUAL.
17. WINNERS & RUNNER'S UP Must indicate which prize (jacket, trophy, voucher or t shirt) on rear side of score sheet after grand final. NO PRIZE'S WILL BE GIVEN TO TEAMS WHO HAVE NOT DONE THIS AT PRESENTATION
18. Under Sydney Western Suburbs Darts League Playing Rules and Dimensions, refer to Rule 14 – NO SMOKING OR DRINKING while you are scoring, NO SMOKING OR DRINKING on or in front of the “oche” line or between the “oche” line & one (1) metre behind that line.

Under Sydney Western Suburbs Darts League Playing Rules and Dimensions, refer to Rule 36 – NO SPEAKING ON MOBILE PHONES IN THE PLAYING AREA.

THESE RULES ARE OF S.W.S.D.L., N.S.W.D.C.(Inc)., D.F.A., W.D.F. AND ARE NOT NEGOTIABLE BY CAPTAINS.

ANY COMPLAINTS WILL BE HANDLED AT S.W.S.D.L. COMMITTEE LEVEL.

19. Delegates' meetings are held on the last Tuesday of each month January to December inclusive at Blacktown R.S.L. Club at 8:00 p.m. A Committee meeting at 7:30 p.m. will precede all meetings.
20. Any club in S.W.S.D.L. not represented at Delegates' meeting will be FINED Five (\$5.00) Dollars. Any club member can attend but only two (2) can sign the attendance book and vote.
21. Under Sydney Western Suburbs Darts League Playing Rules and Dimensions, refer to Rule 29(a) Two (2) or more boards shall be used in all matches including Semi's, Finals and Grand-Finals when necessary.

Under Sydney Western Suburbs Darts League Playing Rules and Dimensions, refer to Rule 29(b) If 2nd Singles has not commenced by 9:45 p.m., TWO (2) or more boards MUST be used.

22. If a host club closes earlier than most clubs, TWO (2) or more boards can be used early. No new games are to be started after the normal closing time of the host club or after "ALL GAMES TO CEASE IN THE SPORTS AREA" is called. ANY UNCOMPLETED GAMES AT CESSATION OF PLAY WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE CREDITED AS A WIN TO THE VISITING TEAM.

DO NOT DESTROY THIS SHEET, KEEP IT WITH YOUR RESULT SHEETS. CLARIFY ANY QUERIES WITH THE RECORDER OR ADJUDICATORS TO AVOID LOSS OF POINTS.
